16/1957**Eaton:**

- a) Allotments – Clerk had spoken with tenant regarding dead chickens and poor conditions around Chicken Coup, tenant had agreed to deal with these matters. – To be monitored going forward
- b) Churchyard – Defer until February meeting for Cllr Hardy to report.
- c) Parish Council Meeting in Eaton – Whilst the Council were grateful for the use of the Church it was felt the venue was not ideal, previously the Village Hall committee had refused to honor the long held arrangement to hold meetings in the Village Hall on the 4th Thursday of the month. It was unanimously agreed that further efforts should be made to resolve this matter, Cllr Coonie offered to speak with Chairman of the Village Hall Committee.

16/1958**Eastwell:**

- a) Traffic Speed Reduction – Highways had forwarded various sketches and details which had been accepted instructions to proceed had been given.
- b) New Footpath from existing towards Eastwell X Roads – A budget figure of £10k had been provided by Highways and it was unanimously agreed to work towards accumulating enough reserves to have this work carried out.
- c) Odd Job Man – It was unanimously agreed to approach Charlie Craft regarding this matter Cllrs Whiston to deal with this.

16/1959**Goadby Marwood:**

- a) Speeding Vans/Trucks – Cllr Woolley advised this had recently become a problem particularly in the run up to Christmas, and although there did not appear to be an easy answer it was agreed the situation should be monitored going forward.

16/1960**Appointment of V Chairman:**

It was unanimously agreed to appoint Cllr Marcus Hardy as Vice Chairman.

19/1961**Mowing Contract:**

It was unanimously agreed to award the contract to Burnt Oak Developments Ltd at a per cut price of £150.00 for Cemetery and Churchyard.


